## Thanks for being a Kid For A Cause!

You represent an amazing group of kids helping kids in need—and the very first group to bring Kidz For A Cause to California! When you talk to people, remember to help your **kid power shine** by making eye contact and smiling!

### What is Kidz For A Cause?

We're a group of philanthropic kids who want to help other kids in need. KFAC was created by a third-grader in Hawaii in 2008, and this is the first year we're expanding to California. Even though several hundred kids get involved, we're still organized and run by kids. So far we've raised \$420,000 for non-profits that benefit kids!

### Why should kids join KFAC?

KFAC inspires kids to achieve amazing things. They learn about teamwork, leadership and philanthropy. Through their FUNraiser, they learn about their true individual abilities as well as the awesomeness of collective kid power! Kids also get community service hours from the RMHC and a Kidz For A Cause cap. Best of all, they get the reward of helping sick kids heal and thrive!

### What is expected when kids join?

All a kid needs to do to be considered a Kid For A Cause is raise \$250. You can FUNraise in any way, including going door to door or asking 10 family and friends to chip in \$25 each. But FUNraisers are most fun and meaningful when Kidz come up with an idea that taps into their passion. If you like to bake, can you sell cupcakes? Can you get your talented friends together for a concert, or organize a pet walk?

### Why haven't I heard about KFAC before?

Kidz For A Cause is based in Hawaii, and this 2017 FUNraising campaign will be our first expansion to California. KFAC has raised over \$400,000 for charities in Hawaii, and we felt ready to take our kid power movement overseas. While you may not have heard about KFAC before, you certainly will hear a lot about us this coming year! ;)

### How old are the Kidz involved?

You're never too young to give back! KFAC was created by Nicki Lee when she was in third grade. We have kids from elementary to high school.

### Who is benefiting from this FUNraiser?

KFAC has selected the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Hawaii and Orange County, California as this year's beneficiaries. Contributions can be made online or in person.

### Can only Orange County kids get involved?

No, kids all across California can be a Kid For A Cause! This year, 100% of the money raised in California will go to the Ronald McDonald House of Orange County.

### Is KFAC a charity or a 501(c)3 non-profit?

No, we're truly just kids who want to help kids. Kidz For A Cause does not take any of the money raised by our kid-powered FUNraisers. We give 100% of contributions to our beneficiary non-profit.

### What should I do as a parent of a Kid For A Cause?

Every Kid For A Cause is doing an important thing, so family support and commitment can mean so much! We ask parents to encourage their child's creativity through discussions and brainstorming, and if your child decides to hold his/her own creative FUNraiser, we ask that you provide guidance and help with the execution to help ensure a successful and rewarding outcome for your child.
